

## SOUTHWESTERN OHIO BASKETBALL LEAGUE RULES

### GENERAL RULES

1. Age divisions are based on the players' 2021-2022 school year grade level. Players may not be more than one year older than the normal age for that grade (based on an August 1 cutoff date).
2. The league will provide both recreation and athletic divisions, numbers permitting. The league reserves the right to move a team up or down at any time.
3. The league will allow teams to play in more than one division or age level, but they must play in the same competitive division in both situations.
4. All divisions will play according to the Ohio High School Athletic Association rules unless otherwise specified in these rules.
5. Rosters must be turned in before receiving schedules. Coaches should carry a copy of their rosters at all times.
6. **Once league schedules are distributed, they are expected to be followed as scheduled.**
7. No player may wear any type of jewelry during the course of a game. This is for your safety and that of the others. No exceptions.
8. Blood Rule: Any player with blood on any part of their uniform or body must remain out of the game until bandages are put onto the wound, the bleeding has stopped and the uniform is changed if needed.
9. Protest: The score book must be signed by the protesting coach and head referee immediately. The score, quarter, and time on the time clock shall be noted. All protests must be submitted (through the mail or by fax) in writing within 72 hours, and a ruling will be made by the Southwestern Ohio Basketball League office within 7 days of notification. A \$100.00 fee must be submitted with your protest and is refundable if the protest is upheld.
10. The League allows gyms to charge admission. There is a maximum of \$3.00 per adult and all children under 18 are free. This is at the discretion of the gym coordinator.

### PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

1. Any player on a OHSAA Jr. High or High School roster for the 2021-2022 season will not be permitted to be on a Southwestern Ohio Basketball League roster for the same season. Exception: If a player is cut or quits their Jr. High or High School team before Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> they may then be added to your roster.
2. No player may be added to your roster after Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> of the current season.
3. No player may play on more than one team within the same division.
4. No player may turn 19 before August 1<sup>st</sup> of the current season.
5. **All 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> grade boys high school coaches must have copies of birth certificates on them at all times.**

### GAME RULES

1. ***Playing time will consist of 20 minute running halves for all age divisions. The Clock will be stop and go during the last minute of each half. Also the clock will stop during all team and referee timeouts. This rule will be in place this year to help keep games on time so gyms are not overcrowded during our COVID protocols.***
2. Intermission will be approximately 3 minutes between halves. If games are running behind, this may be adjusted by the referee or gym coordinator.
3. Overtime will be 2 minutes stop and go. All time outs are carried over from regulation and each team shall receive one additional time out per overtime.
4. Each team shall receive 4 time outs per game and can be used at any time.
5. Bonus: The 1 and 1 bonus is in effect on and after the team's 7<sup>th</sup> personal foul in any half. The double bonus is in effect on and after the team's 10<sup>th</sup> personal foul.
6. The 3 point goal is in effect for all age groups if the gym is clearly marked.
7. The 2<sup>nd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade boys and all girls' divisions will use the 28.5" intermediate size ball in the Southwestern Ohio Basketball League. The boys 7<sup>th</sup> grade through High School divisions will use the 30" regulation size basketball.
8. ***The league reserves the right to make any adjustments necessary for the betterment of the League.***

### SPECIAL RULES

1. The 2<sup>nd</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> grade divisions will shoot free throws from the bottom of the circle. This will also determine their 3 second lane.

2. The 5<sup>th</sup> grade through High School divisions will shoot their free throws from the regulation line. This also will determine their 3 second lane.
3. There will be no back court pressing allowed in the 2<sup>nd</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> grade recreational divisions. ***In the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade boys athletic we will allow pressing only if both teams agree to press before the game.*** The player must be allowed to have both feet and the ball across the mid court line to be considered in the front court. Once the player is in the front court, any half court defense is permitted.
4. **During the last minute of the game in the divisions mentioned in Special Rules #3, the clock will stop on each dead ball situation and after made baskets. The clock will not restart until the ball is touched in the front court. The 10 second rule still applies in the back court.**
5. Teams in the recreation divisions must release back court pressure when their team leads by 15 points or more. A technical may be called at the referee's discretion.

## REFEREES

1. Each team is responsible for paying one referee before a game can begin. The following is the pay schedule for each division:

2. The referee, or gym coordinator, has the right to clear the gym or building of anyone that interferes with the game in any manner.
3. The referee shall be approached by the head coach only during the game.
4. Only players and coaches listed on the league roster are permitted to sit in the bench area.
5. **If a team does not show up at a regularly scheduled game, you will forfeit your \$50 deposit.**

## CONDUCT

1. All unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by any participant or spectator, by Southwestern Ohio Basketball and its officials. This includes such items as:
  - a. pushing, shoving , fighting, etc.
  - b. the use of profanity in any manner
  - c. verbal abuse of other players, coaches, or officials
  - d. any dangerous or illegal unsportsmanlike play.
2. Any player, coach, or spectator ejected from a Southwestern Ohio Basketball game will be suspended for its team's next league or tournament game.
3. Any player, coach, or spectator ejected for fighting in a Southwestern Ohio Basketball game will be suspended its team's next two games pending a league investigation. League decisions will be final.
4. Any player, coach, or spectator ejected for a second time in a session will be suspended for the remainder of that session pending a league investigation. League decisions will be final.
5. HS Division: A 21 year old or older coach must be present at all league and tournament games, or the game shall be forfeited.

## TOURNAMENT

1. All teams will be entered into the single elimination post season tournament.
2. Coaches are responsible for paying the refs still in tourney.
3. The post season tournament will begin approximately one week after the regular season ends.
4. ***Teams that perform strongly or poorly in their respective divisions will be moved up or down accordingly.***
5. ***The tournament format will be determined no later than Feb. 1<sup>st</sup> by the league officials AND IS NOT SEEDED!***

## AWARDS

1. Team and individual awards will be given to the league champions. (Maximum 12)
2. Individual awards will be given to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in the post season tournament. (Maximum 12)
