

## 2019 SOUTHWESTERN OHIO PRESEASON TOURNEY

Coach,

We are excited to have your team participate in the 25th Annual Preseason Tourney. Please make sure to bring your roster to your first game if you have not already sent one in. We will be charging an admission at the gate for adults of \$5, \$2 for students and kids free. We are looking forward to seeing each one of you. Let's make this the best tournament in town!

### GAME RULES

1. Playing time will consist of 6 minute stop and go quarters for all divisions.
2. Intermission will be approximately 3 minutes between halves. If games are running behind, this may be adjusted by the referee or gym coordinator.
3. Overtime will be 2 minutes stop and go. Each team will receive one additional time out for the entire overtime period.
4. Each team shall receive 4 time outs per game and can be used at any time.
5. Bonus: The 1 and 1 bonus is in effect on and after the team's 7<sup>th</sup> personal foul in any half. The double bonus is in effect on and after the team's 10<sup>th</sup> personal foul.
6. The 3 point goal is in effect for all age groups.
7. The 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade boys and all girls' divisions will use the 28.5" intermediate size ball. The 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys' divisions will use the 30" regulation size basketball.
8. We will follow OHSA rules unless otherwise indicated in the special rules below. **THERE WILL BE NO PROTESTS!**

### SPECIAL RULES

1. The 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade division will shoot free throws from the bottom of the circle. This will also determine their 3 second lane.
2. The 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade divisions will shoot their free throws from the regulation line. This also will determine their 3 second lane.
3. There will be no back court pressing allowed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade divisions (unless both teams agree before the game). The player must be allowed to have both feet and the ball across the mid court line to be considered in the front court. Once the player is in the front court, any half court defense is permitted.
4. ***During the last minute of the game where no pressing is allowed, the clock will stop on each dead ball situation and after made baskets. The clock will not restart until the ball is touched in the front court. The 10 second rule still applies in the back court.***
5. Maximum amount of awards per team is 12.
